Jeremiah 2:1-13 Title: What Kind of Water Are You Drinking?



ISRAEL drank "polluted water instead of spring water".

Context: God is about to bring divine judgment on Judah because of their continuous rejection of Him.

- **I.** In preparation for this coming judgment, God sends Jeremiah in 588 BC to preach 13 sermons of judgment against them.
- **II.** Jeremiah started preaching by talking about how Israelites used to be faithful. He goes back to the Exodus where it talks about God who brought them out of Egypt. First, he speaks of the devotion of their youth.
- III. Jeremiah said, "they loved God like a bride loves her husband."

 "My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken me, the spring of living water, and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water." (Verse 12 NIV)
- **A.** One important question we should be asking ourselves today is, "What was it like when I first had a refreshing experience of God?"
- **B.** What kind of H20 are you drinking this morning?
- "Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost. Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labor on what does not satisfy? Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and you will delight in the richest of fare. Give ear and come to me; listen, that you may live." (Isaiah 55:1-3a NIV)
