**Psalms 118:1-17, Mark 11:1-10 Title: Certainty in Uncertain Times**

We live in uncertain times. We do not know what tomorrow will bring. One thing we are certain about is that God has not changed. The Psalmist 118 declares that God has not changed. He says to give thanks to the Lord because his love last forever.

Psalms 118:4-6a declares, "Let those who fear the Lord say it: God's faithful love last forever. "In tight circumstances, I cried out to the Lord. The Lord answered me with wide-open spaces. The Lord is for me-I won't be afraid..."

Mark 11:7-10, "They brought the colt to Jesus and threw their clothes upon it, and he sat on it. Many people spread out their clothes on the road while others spread branches cut from the fields. Those in front of him and those following were shouting, "*Hosanna! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the Lord!* Blessings on the coming kingdom of our ancestor David! Hosanna in the highest!"

Hosanna-means two things:

1. It is an appeal to God for deliverance.
2. It is a word for a praise to Jesus for bringing hope.
