Scriptures: Romans 8:1-6, 2 Peter 1:2-4 Title: The Law of Spirit

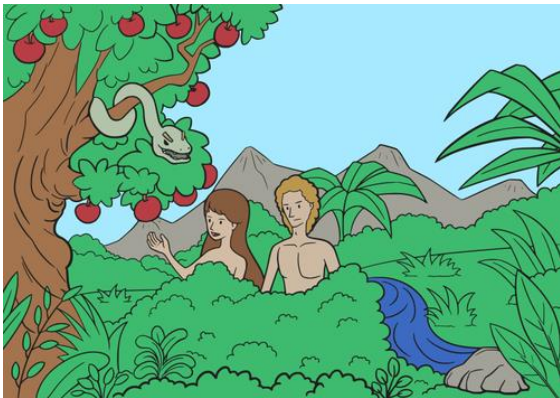
Introduction: The law of the Holy Spirit is an inward principle of action that the Spirit of Christ has activated within us.



The word 'law' in Romans chapter 8 does not mean an external set of rules from a ruler.

“There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death.” Romans 8:1-2

“Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.” Genesis 2:16-17



The law of the Holy Spirit is within you, but you must be deliberate about engaging it. Some of the law of the Holy Spirit are as follow: **faith, hope and love.**

“Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.” (2 Peter 1:2-4)
