Title: "Ascension"

Introduction: Why did the disciples have great joy when Jesus ascended?" (Luke 24:52)

There are three reasons that Jesus' ascension should cause us to worship Him and rejoice:

1. Jesus' ascension should cause us to worship Him and rejoice because it signifies the completion of His earthly ministry.

"I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do" John 17:4 NIV.

2. Jesus' ascension should cause us to worship him because the ascension began an intercessory ministry for us. (Rom. 8:34; Heb. 7:25)

3. Jesus' ascension should cause us to worship Him and rejoice because it signifies the beginning of His heavenly mission through the power of the Holy Spirit.
