Introduction:



In the book of Hebrews, Apostle Paul uses a metaphor of running to encourage Christians to persevere, press on and “run” as if competing for a prize.

Three lessons to learn from the Scripture verses:

1. Faith is a run

- “Those that have Faith in the Lord will renew their strength They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary”. (Isaiah 40:31
- “Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize.” 1Corinthians (9:24 NIV)

2. Faith is a challenge (Hebrews 11:31)

3. Faith is Difficult

CONCLUSION: Faith is a run, faith is a challenge, and faith is difficult.
