Scripture: Philippians 4:10-13

Title: Give All You Can

Introduction: Today we come to John Wesley's third rule which is, "give all we can." There are many Scriptures in the Bible that talk about give all you can.

Example: Philippians 4:10-13.

Paul wrote back to the church and expressed his joy (see verse 10). In what ways can giving make you a joyful person?

1. Giving renews our concern (verse 10)
2. Giving teaches us contentment (verse 11)
3. Giving makes us partners in ministry (verse 14)
4. Giving grows our faith in God (verse 17-19)

Verse 19 encourages us to take the step of faith and to give, trusting God to meet our needs.

- God meets our needs personally ("my God").
- He meets our needs liberally ("all your needs").
- He meets our needs gloriously ("according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus").
