June 16, 2024 Hebrews 13:7-9; 1 Corinthians 13:11-12 Title: Jesus Doesn't Change, But Humans Change



Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. (Hebrews 13:8 ESV)

- I. What is significant about these three time periods: Yesterday, Today and Forever?
- Yesterday: It is crucial that Jesus Christ be the same yesterday as he is today because yesterday is when Jesus Christ showed us in history what he is really like.

"And so at even the quails came and covered the camp: and in the morning the dew lay round about the host. And when the dew that was fallen was ascended, behold, a small round thing was upon the face of the wilderness, small as the hoary frost upon the earth. And when the children of Israel saw it, they said one to another, It is Manna, for they wist not what it was. And Moses said unto them, this is the bread which the Lord hath given you to eat." (Exodus 16:13-15 GNV).

- Today: "Anyone who loves me will <u>obey</u> my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them." (John 14:23 NIV)
- Tomorrow: It is <u>crucial</u> that Jesus Christ be the same tomorrow as he was yesterday and today.
- II. Jesus never changes, but humans change.

"When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things." (1 Corinthians 13:11)
